Prospective bidders must be registered on eDumbe Local Municipality's Suppliers Database and National Treasury Web "Central Suppliers Database". Proof of CSD (Central Supplier Database) and registration summary extract need to be attached to your bid. Qualifying bidders may be invited in to do presentation.

Completed Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope labelled the bid Reference number and the name of the project and must be deposited in the Bid Box at 10 Hoog Street, Paulpietersburg 3180 by **12H00** on **30 June 2017**. Bids will be opened in public, immediately thereafter. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, electronic and late bids will not be accepted. This invitation to bid is subject to the Preferential Procurement Guidelines and Bid documents must be completed fully and accurately to avoid being disqualified by the eDumbe Municipality.

The contract is beyond the three years covered in the annual budget of the municipality and the public is accordingly invited to comment on the contract and which comments must be submitted by ordinary mail within 14 days of the notice to the municipal manager. The bidder may be required to present the bid in person in support of their bid proposal on request by the eDumbe Municipality. The eDumbe Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and reserves the right to accept a bid in whole or any part. The municipality further reserves the right not to award this bid.
